

PAHRUMP AT A GLANCE

DAY 1

Check in at your hotel. Once you've settled in, head to Pahrump Valley Winery to get a taste of Symphony's Restaurant. We suggest the Winemaker's Club or Imported Baked Brie (honestly, you can't go wrong with any of their menu items). Stay a while to enjoy breathtaking views of the sun setting behind Pahrump's surrounding mountains.

DAY 2

Wake up early and hit the road toward Death Valley National Park. It'll take you just over an hour to get there. Make sure to bring plenty of sunblock and water because you'll have more than three million acres of desert to explore. Guided tours are also available. You could easily lose track of time, so plan ahead.

If you leave Death Valley by 1 p.m., you'll likely get back just in time for lunch. We recommend heading to the Grill Room at Mountain Falls Golf Course for a delicious lunch overlooking the water. If you're up to it, try your skills on the course or take a few swings on the driving range.

For those who need to cool down, head to Lake Spring Mountain at Spring Mountain Motor Resort & Country Club and fly high into the air on water jetpacks (available Wed - Sun). You can also hang out by the lake for a swim, or test your core-strength on a paddleboard or kayak. Be sure to grab a bite and maybe a cocktail from the Tiki Bar (lake activities and Tiki Bar are open Sat & Sun).

For dinner, make your way to Stockman's Steakhouse at Pahrump Nugget Hotel & Casino, a classic American steakhouse with a modern twist. And, Thrillist named Stockman's one of the top steakhouses in Nevada. After dinner, you can test your luck on the casino floor.

Now, it's time to head to bed and get ready for the next day's adventure.
